HAS YOUR INCOME GONE DOWN?

Child Support Agencies Are Here To Serve Both Parents



If you have legal custody:

- If you don't have a child support order, your Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) can assist you in establishing a child support order.
- If you have an order and your income level has changed, you may be eligible for the agency to review and adjust the amount of your child support order.



If you are paying child support:

- If your income level has changed, you may be eligible for the agency to review and adjust the amount of your support order.
- If you have changed employers, remember to notify the agency so it can ensure that a withholding is sent to the new employer on a timely basis to prevent or minimize missed payments.
- If you are unemployed, a percentage of your unemployment compensation can be withheld to help meet your support obligation.
- The CSEA may be able to refer you to resources within your county to assist you in looking for a new job.
